## Diabetes <br> Complications



Diabetes is a progressive disease that can lead to various health complications. Call your Doctor immediately if you experience any of the following conditions.

## Nerve damage

Diabetic peripheral neuropathy most offen affects the feet and legs. Damage also occurs to the blood vessels, increasing susceptibility to infections and sores or ulcers that are very slow to heal.

## Warning signs of nerve damage

Numbness, an odd feeling in one or both feet, or a sharp pain, weakness or a tingling or burning feeling in any part of the body.

## Eye issues

In diabetic retinopathy, the small blood vessels in the retina are damaged and weakened.

## Warning signs of eye issues

Extreme redness, pressure or pain in the eye or unusual changes in vision, such as sudden loss of vision in either;or both eyes, blurred vision for more than two days, or dark spots called "floaters" moving across your field of vision.

## Kidney disease

Diabetic nephropathy can damage kidney blood vessels so that the kidneys cannot work properly. High blood pressure and high blood glucose levels are the main causes.

## Warning signs of kidney disease

Frequent urination, burning or difficulty during urination, blood in the urine, swelling of hands and feet and around the eyes, or high blood pressure.

## What else can I do to prevent or delay the complications of diabetes? <br> Keeping your blood glucose, blood pressure and blood lipids (fats) under control are the primary ways to reduce the complications of diabetes. <br> Other ways to reduce the risks and complications of diabeles

- Exercise regularly.
- Consult a dietitian and follow a balanced diet low in fats.
- See your Doctor or other health care provider regularly and remind them to check for the early signs of complications.
- If you smoke, quit.
- See your Doctor (or an Ophthalmologist or Optometrist) once a year for a dilated eye exam.

Did You Know?... People with diabetes are 75\% more likely to develop gum disease. According to Diabetes Canada, having diabetes gives you a $75 \%$ higher risk of getting gum disease such as gingivitis or periodontal disease. The Canadian Dental Association states that there is now sufficient evidence to support the relationship between periodontal disease and diabetes. Inflammatory diseases such as periodontitis can be worse for a diabetic patient as their immune system is already compromised.
