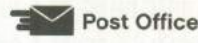

Cold or Flu?



The cold and the flu (influenza) are each caused by different viruses but both are respiratory conditions with very similar symptoms.

Let's look at the differences which will help you approach the cold or the flu with the appropriate treatment.

The Common Cold

The cold is a viral infection of the nose and throat, takes one to three days for the symptoms to appear, and lasts seven to 10 days. Symptoms usually improve within a week. Colds usually occur more often in the spring and fall with the change of weather. The cold virus is infectious and can be passed to other people through close contact, shaking hands or touching objects handled by the infected person. Seniors are more susceptible to the cold virus.

The Flu

The flu is a very contagious viral illness that strikes people usually between November and April and can affect up to 25% of the population in a year. The incubation period is one to four days and infected people become contagious before symptoms appear.

The following shows the differences between cold and flu symptoms:

Symptom

- * Aches and pain
- * Fever and or chills
- * Headache
- * Onset
- * Fatigue and weakness
- * Extreme exhaustion
- * Sore throat
- * Stuffy nose
- * Sneezing
- * Chest discomfort and cough

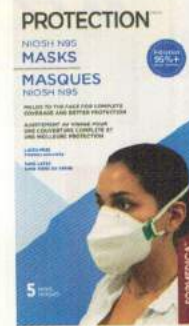
